## FBI releases new 2022 Hate Crime Data Collection & Training Manual

On March 1st, the FBI Criminal Justice Information Services (CJIS) Division released a new Hate Crime Data Collection & Training Manual. This version (3.0) is an update from the previous edition released back in 2015 to align with the newly expanded data values within the Religious Bias category. First and foremost, this new manual focuses on the NIBRS incident report format and removes all references to the Summary Reporting System. Version 3.0 additionally includes the list of all Federal and Tribal-specific NIBRS offense code that qualify as Hate Crime reportable. Finally, this manual includes new training scenarios to better identify Anti-Asian bias motivation, as well as includes guidance on reporting non-binary gender bias within the existing Gender Identity bias options of 72=Anti-Gender Non-conforming and 71=Anti-Transgender.

## Reporting Warrant Arrests in NIBRS

Properly reporting arrests in NIBRS can be confusing to the both the party making the arrest/serving the warrant AND the jurisdictional agency that originated the warrant. Here are some guidelines to follow when making that Arrest Segment determination for your jurisdiction:

- If YOUR AGENCY is the holder of the warrant AND makes the arrest, then YOUR AGENCY reports that arrest;
- If YOUR AGENCY is the holder of the warrant, but OTHER AGENCY makes the arrest on your warrant, then YOUR AGENCY still reports the arrest;
- If OTHER AGENCY is the holder of the warrant, but YOUR AGENCY makes the arrest on their warrant, then OTHER AGENCY reports the arrest.

## Lesser Included vs Mutually Exclusive?

A "Lesser Included Offense" in NIBRS is an offense that is an element of another offense and cannot be reported as also occurring against the same victim within the same incident. A "Mutually Exclusive Offense" is an offense that cannot occur to the same Victim per NIBRS definitions within the same incident. For example, AGGRAVATED ASSAULT, SIMPLE ASSAULT, and INTIMIDATION are all Lesser Included Offenses of MURDER.

Likewise, RAPE, SODOMY, SEXUAL ASSAULT WITH AN OBJECT, and FONDLING are Mutually Exclusive Offenses of INCEST.
