"Criminal Sexual Contact" to Replace Fondling Offense

While no implementation year has been announced by the FBI National UCR Program Office, the CJIS Advisory Policy Board voted in 2021 to eventually replace the NIBRS offense title of 11D=FONDLING with 11D=CRIMINAL SEXUAL CONTACT.

CRIMINAL SEXUAL CONTACT will be defined as "[t]he intentional touching of the clothed or unclothed body parts without the consent of the victim for the purpose of sexual degradation, sexual gratification, or sexual humiliation; or [t]he forced touching by the victim of the actor's clothed or unclothed body parts, without consent of the victim for the purpose of sexual degradation, sexual gratification, or sexual humiliation. This includes instances where the victim is incapable of giving consent because of age or incapacity due to temporary or permanent mental or physical impairment or intoxication."

NIBRS adds 3 New Relationship Codes for 2023

Pursuant to the approval of the CJIS Advisory Policy Board in 2021, NIBRS will be adding the following three (3) new data values to Data Element 35 (Relationship of Victim to Offender) for 2023 data collection:

- o FP = VICTIM WAS FOSTER PARENT
- o FC = VICTIM WAS FOSTER CHILD
- o CO = VICTIM WAS COHABITANT (NON-INTIMATE/ NON-FAMILY RELATIONSHIP)
